Who is Eligible and What is the Amount of the Tuition Assistance?

- Incoming/Returning 9th-12th grade students (one male, one female) of Delone Catholic High School
- \$1,000, accompanied by a certificate and award – amount to be used for tuition assistance at Delone Catholic

How Do I Apply?

- Complete application, essay and 3 letters of recommendation
- Submit application to Roots for Boots, P.O. Box 213, New Oxford, PA 17350
- Application deadline, (postmarked by) April 15

Who Selects the Recipient?

- Roots for Boots board members
- Delone Catholic administration/faculty
- Elementary administration/faculty (if applicant is currently in 8th grade)

How Will Applicants be Judged?

- ***Selfless Acts of Service*** – understanding that it is better to give than to receive
- ***Honor*** – to live by ultimate ethical and moral behavior, meaning modeling a life of integrity and dependability; respect for human dignity; acting responsibly while being accountable for actions and fulfilling obligations
- ***Courage*** – finding the inner strength to do what is right, no matter what the challenge and lead by example
- ***Commitment*** – to love of country in a spirit of patriotism and respect for the flag and the National Anthem; dedication to values this country was founded upon – always striving to achieve excellence, no matter what the endeavor

How Will the Award be Administered?

- Presentation of the award will occur at Delone Catholic's end of year awards ceremony by Major Borden, or a member of his family in his absence, in conjunction with Roots for Boots CEO, Christy Lucas
